
The Data Model



- Defined Data Model

- Real-Time Data

The Good






Details Matter



- Perception of low technical requirement
- Documentation trails development
- REST API knowledge & skill required
- Lack of coding examples
- Slow/Limited vendor adoption






Find APIs


























APIs (versions, elements, support) are evolving

- Multiple API versions used by different entities
- Different data attributes based on API version used

Inconsistent Vendor support

- Limited data compared to P2P offerings
- Requests for institution to build connectors

Can be slow to integration initially

- High learning curve
- Middleman trust concerns

Security practices evolving

- IP restrictions challenging
- Open API bus as opposed to selected
